

## Special Issue of COLD REGIONS SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY

For authors who wish to publish their papers through a peer-reviewed outlet in an international scientific journal, you may consider submitting your work for the Special Issue of Cold Regions Science and Technology (CRST). The journal publishes articles relating to scientific and technical problems of natural and artificial cold environments. Emphasis is given to applied science, mainly the physical sciences, with broad coverage of the physics, chemistry and mechanics of ice, ice-water systems, and ice-bonded soils.

A special issue of CRST has been published with pertinent papers from the ISSW over the last few workshops. Publication is dependent on favorable review of the special edition editorial committee. All papers are rigorously reviewed under the normal journal process, and submission and publication in the proceedings does not guarantee acceptance for publication in CRST.

Additionally:

- 1) Papers must be original scientific work that has not been previously published in a refereed journal.
- 2) Authors should expand on the technical aspects of their papers submitted for the ISSW proceedings. A paper that is identical to the proceedings paper will not be accepted for publication in CRST. Additional information could include additional aspects of the problem, additional data and analyses, more detail of the methods, discussion and results, or additional theory.
- 3) Papers submitted for CRST should follow the guidelines for authors available from the CRST website [http://www.elsevier.com/wps/find/journaldescription.cws\\_home/503326/authorinstructions](http://www.elsevier.com/wps/find/journaldescription.cws_home/503326/authorinstructions). Note that the guidelines are NOT the same as those for the ISSW proceedings.
- 4) Papers must be double-spaced and have wide margins for reviewer's comments.
- 5) Authors submitting papers for CRST must submit online via the CRST website prior to November 1, 2008.

LATE PAPERS WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED FOR THE SPECIAL ISSUE

- 6) If you are submitting to CRST, you must also provide an extended abstract or paper to the proceedings. Authors who do not submit to the ISSW08 proceedings will not be eligible for publication in CRST.
